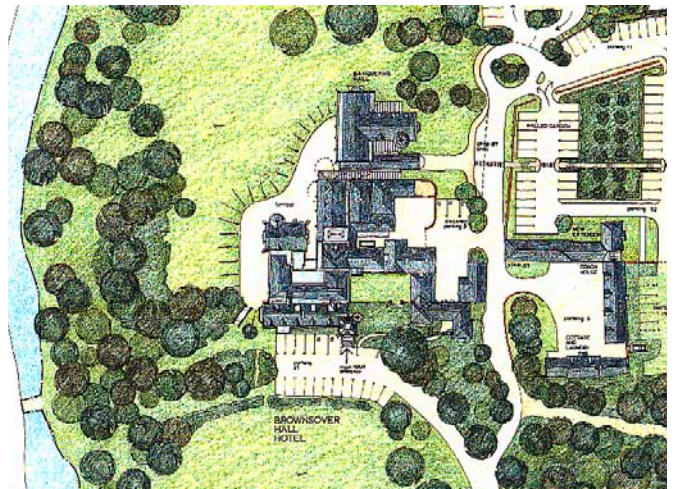

Expansion of Banqueting and Conference Facilities

With expertise in sensitive contextual design, Acanthus Clews achieved approval for works to the attractive Sir Gilbert Scott designed Grade II* Listed hotel. The works comprised: new conference facilities and kitchens, together with a conversion and extension of existing stables and coach house to form additional bedrooms. The hotel had a good reputation as a venue for conference trade, but suffered from limited space.

Consequently Acanthus Clews were asked to put forward a scheme to provide additional meeting rooms and conference facilities including a new banqueting suite and kitchens to serve both the new accommodation and the existing restaurants and meeting rooms. Diaper brickwork and stone detailing to match the existing was specified with a hammer beam ceiling in the the banqueting hall.
